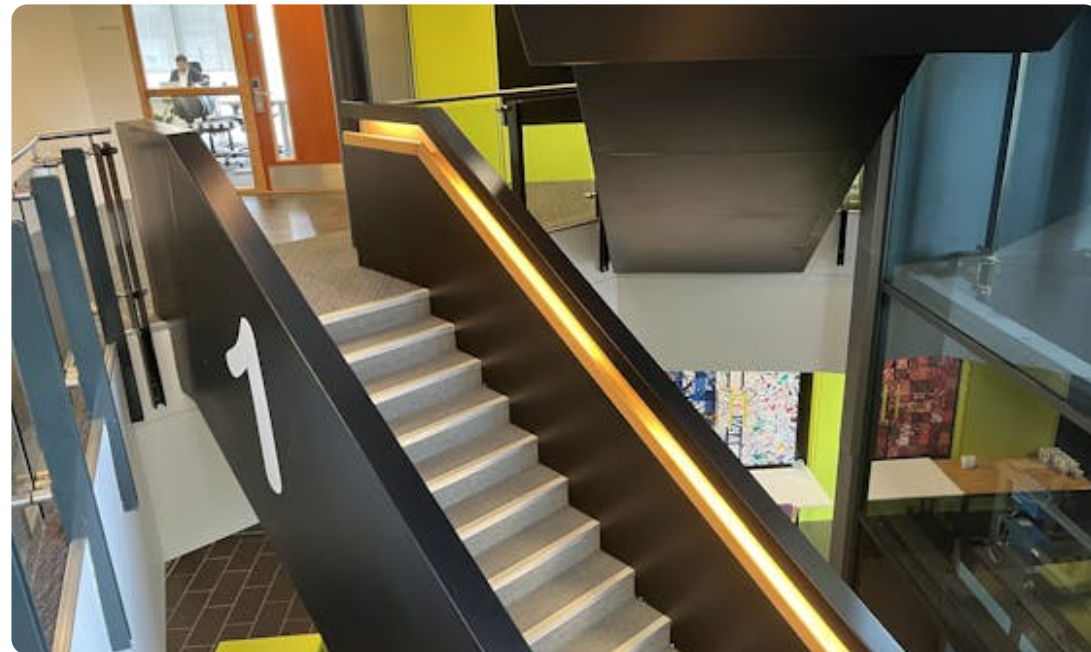

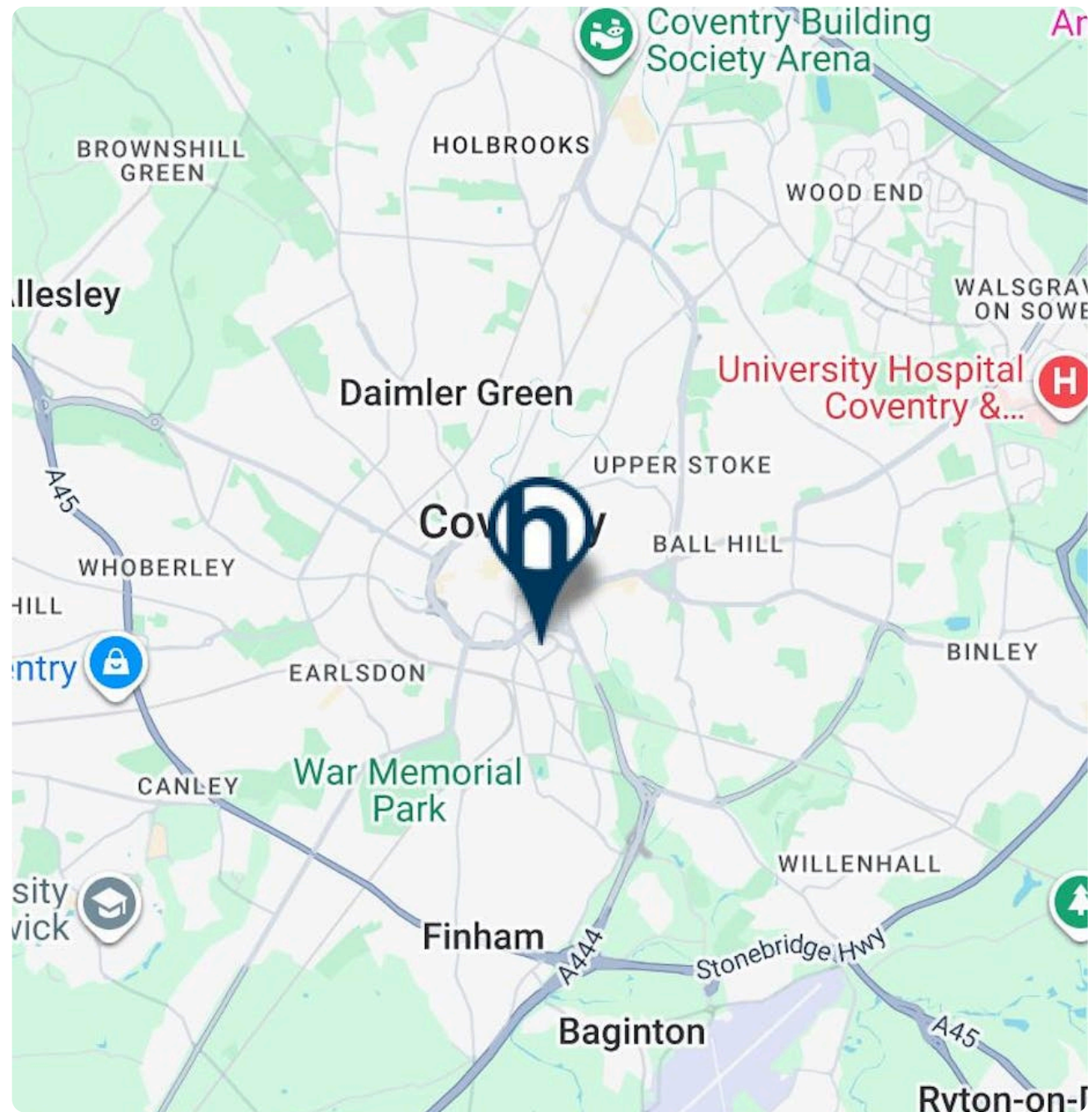

Location

Coventry University Technology Park well located on the south side of central Coventry, a short distance from the ring road (A4053) which in turn connects to the A45, A46 and M6 motorway.

The city centre is situated approximately half a mile to the north and the station just a short walk to the west, providing regular services to London Euston (55 mins) and Birmingham (25 mins). Birmingham International Airport is located approximately 10 miles to the north-west.

Coventry is a city in central England. It's known for the medieval Coventry Cathedral, which was left in ruins after a WWII bombing. A 20th-century replacement, with abstract stained glass, stands beside it. The collection at the Herbert Art Gallery & Museum includes paintings of local heroine Lady Godiva. A statue of her, naked on horseback, is nearby. The 14th-century St. Mary's Guildhall has a vaulted crypt.

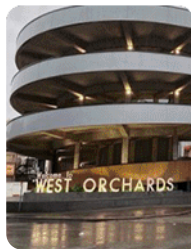
