OVERVIEW

The Woolgate Centre is the prime shopping centre in the heart of Witney in Oxfordshire. The scheme benefits from an 800-space car park to the rear of the scheme, offering free car parking to all customers.

It is an attractive shopping centre built in traditional Cotswold stone in the town's conservation area. The scheme is anchored by Waitrose supermarket, and has a widespread retail offer that includes national and local brands.

LOCATION

Witney is a prosperous market town 25 miles from Cirencester and 26 miles north east of Swindon. The town has excellent road and rail infrastructure, with easy access from both the M40 and M4 motorways.
